

# TempO

## What to do.

Standard procedures for timed controls are used, with the exceptions that in TempO there is the possibility of a zero answer and that instead of the pointing board and control card, electronic SI e-cards are used. These will be cleared and issued to a specific competitor at registration; the card must then be activated by dinging the Competition Start before heading for the first control.

The decision point will have a document tray housing two rows of units, labelled A, B, C and D, Z and Start, on a 'table'.

At each control, the competitor will ding the 'Start' unit (bottom right), as this beeps, the map will be uncovered. On making a decision the competitor must ding in the relevant unit for their choice.

More than one control problem may be set from the same position using the same equipment, however, the result is separately recorded. For this demonstration some units may also be moved to a second location.

Upon completion of the course, the competitor will return to the registration tent, dinging the competition Finish unit before going to Download. A printout can then be entered into a revised format of the standard results spreadsheet, which will be issued with the solution sheet some time after all those trying the Demonstration course have finished.
