

Answer to control # 6: Description: *Southern Rocky hill, NW side*

E is the correct answer.

This control site was chosen for the complexity of rocky knolls. The challenge is to determine which terrain features are represented by which symbols on the map, to judge distance, and to determine which side is the NW side. The trail junction and the snow maker (man made object) help you to locate the viewing station.

On the map, you can see the three rocky hills. You can also locate the vegetation corner (near the middle hill) and the single tree (near the southernmost hill), which may be used as reference points.

In the terrain, you can make out which is the northernmost hill of the three and thus eliminate A as the correct control. Although it may be difficult to make out the other rocky hills, the vegetation corner SW of the northernmost hill is visible. That is where control B is located, so it is not B. Since control C is in close proximity to where the vegetation boundary turns back southward, you might correctly assume it is close to the middle hill and eliminate it. That leaves D or E. The solution is found by identifying the single tree that is close to the southern hill. The control next to the single tree would be on the NW side of the southern hill, therefore E.
